### **Terms of Reference for Graduate Diploma in Career Development Scholarship**

Up to 6 each year – generally awarded in Semester 1. One scholarship is reserved for Maori or Pasifika applicants.

Applicants must be accepted into the AUT Graduate Diploma in Career Development. An AUT Scholarship Application Form must be completed and submitted by the deadline.

In addition to the AUT Scholarship Application Form, an applicant must submit a minimum 300 word statement that describes his/her goals for work in the careers field. Specific focus must be on a vision for assisting the career development of clients and how attainment of the Graduate Diploma will support you in fulfilling this vision.

Also include a statement of your financial need.

The intent is that it be awarded one time only to a particular individual. However if there are no other applicants in the subsequent year, it can be awarded to the same individual.

### **Selection**

Applicants will be considered by a selection panel consisting of staff from the Graduate Diploma in Career Development Programme

No scholarship will be awarded upon any occasion if the panel is of the opinion that there is no applicant of sufficient merit applying for the award.

### **Conditions of acceptance**

This scholarship may not be held in conjunction with any other fees scholarship.

The recipient may hold additional non-tuition fee based scholarships with the approval of the Head of School and the Scholarships Office

Recipients will not be considered for automatic renewal of this scholarship, but may submit a second application for consideration.

One per year – generally awarded in Semester 1.
